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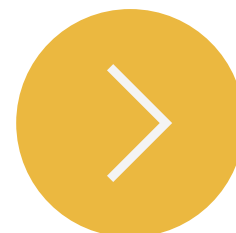

NOUNS – DEFINITION

Oxford dictionary:

"A word (other than a pronoun) used to identify any of a class of people, places, or things (common noun), or to name a particular one of these (proper noun)."

Easier:

A noun is a word that describes a specific thing, set of things or creature.

Examples: Tommy, man, dog, lamp, computer, weather, light...

NOUNS – CHARACTERISTICS

Nouns use articles:

- "das Haus"
- "die Lampe"
- "das Wetter"

You have to write all nouns with a capital letter at all times and not just at the beginning of a sentence.

Compound nouns must be written together

- "der Führerschein" – der Führer + der Schein (driver's license)
- "die Wasserflasche" – die Flasche + das Wasser (water bottle)
