WHAT ARE W-QUESTION?

W-Questions are questions with question words. All German question words start with the letter "w". You are asking for specific information. It is impossible to answer with only "yes" or "no."

Wessen?	Belonging/ Ownership	Whose?	„ Wessen Hund ist das?“ - „Das ist Annas Hund.“
Wo?	Location	Where?	„ Wo wohnst du?“ - „Ich wohne in Dortmund.“
Wohin?	Direction	Where to?	„ Wohin gehst du?“ - „Ich gehe nach Hause.“
Woher?	Origin	From where?	„ Woher kommst du?“ - „Ich komme von der Arbeit.“

Warum?	Reason	Why?	„ Warum hast du nicht angerufen?“ - „Weil mein Akku leer ist.“

Welche(r,s)?	Choice	Which...?	„ Welches Auto kaufst du?“ - „Das blaue Auto!“

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
